

What do I need to know?

The 2017 awards will build on the success of the last sixteen years. The deadline for the submission of nominations is 2359 Monday 2 October.

When do I have to have completed study?

You must have completed personal development between 01 August 2016 and 31 July 2017 to qualify.

Can I nominate myself?

You are able to nominate yourself, but your nomination must be endorsed by your Line Manager.

Who is required to complete PD Unit of the Year nominations?

The PD Unit of the Year nomination must be signed off by the Commanding Officer. The winner will be selected by the RACPD Board of Trustees.

Am I able to self-nominate for Learner of the Year or Achiever of the Year?

No, these two awards will be decided by the panel from all other submissions.

How do I complete a nomination?

You may send in nominations electronically or by hand, but if they are unable to be read then they will be returned and asked to be resubmitted. Nominations will not be accepted without a current head and shoulders photograph.

Where can I find the nomination forms?

Forms are available to download at www.racpd.org.uk or from your PD Advisor.

How is my nomination judged?

A judging panel will sit in October including a RACPD Trustee, a senior RA officer and the Chief Executive and two directors of RACPD. During this time the Learner of the Year and Achiever of the Year will be selected from all award submissions.

When will we hear the results?

Commanding Officers will be informed of the results first, then successful individuals will be contacted one week later, to allow time for them to be congratulated within the unit.

When do the presentations of awards take place?

The presentations will take place in December 2017.
